Dear Mr. O'Brien:

I this day received a copy of what purports to be a certificate from the Clerk of the Civil District Court for the Parish of Orleans, to which was attached a copy of a Motion and Order in a case in that Court styled Douglas v. Gallinghouse, which was accompanied by a letter to me dated October 18, 1967, from Sidney W. Provensal, Jr., attorney for the defendants in the captioned cause, and which letter states in part:

"I am enclosing herewith photostatic copy of affidavit and certificate which I have filed this day in the Sobol proceedings."

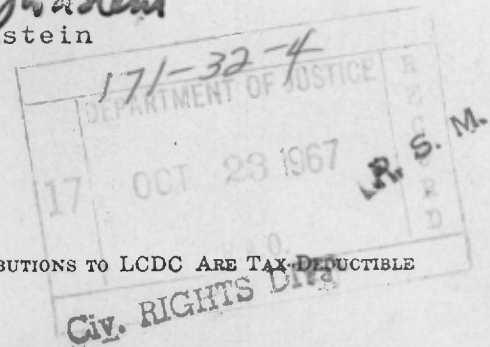
