WHEREAS, Plaintiff CITY AND COUNTY OF SAN FRANCISCO ("Plaintiff" or "San 1 Francisco") filed a complaint in this action on January 31, 2017, and filed a Second Amended 2 Complaint on May 23, 2017; 3 WHEREAS, the Court entered an Order on Plaintiff's Motion for Summary Judgment 4 ("Order") on November 20, 2017, finding that Plaintiff is entitled to summary judgment on Counts 5 Two and Three of its Second Amended Complaint concerning Section 9(a) of Executive Order 13768 6 (Dkt. No. 200);1 and 7 8 WHEREAS, the Order declined to resolve San Francisco's claim in Count One regarding 8 9 U.S.C. § 1373, finding that this claim is "better addressed at the time I consider upcoming motions in related litigation. City and County of San Francisco v. Sessions, No. 17-cv-4642-WHO; California v. 10 Sessions, No. 17-cv-4701-WHO ('the related litigation')"; and 11 12 WHEREAS, the parties agree that San Francisco's claim for declaratory relief regarding 8 U.S.C. § 1373 shall be raised through an Amended Complaint that San Francisco will file in the case 13 of City and County of San Francisco v.
