ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, following oral argument on this day on Plaintiffs' motion (Doc. No. 73) to compel production of documents, that the motion is **GRANTED in part and DENIED in part** as follows and as more fully discussed at oral argument: Within **seven (7) days** of the date of this Order, the parties shall meet and confer on the following topics:

- (1) Search terms and protocol to address Plaintiffs' discovery requests, as narrowed;
- (2) A list of key custodians most likely to have discoverable emails such that wholesale production of their non-privileged emails is appropriate;
- (3) The sequence, manner, and format of production;
- (4) The timeline for production of emails that Defendant has already reviewed for privilege;
- (5) The timeline for production of emails that Defendant has not yet reviewed for privilege; and
- (6) How the emails on the two flash drives at issue in Plaintiffs' motion (and discussed at oral argument) equate to the universe of discoverable emails in Defendant's possession, custody, or control.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, within **14 days** of the date of this Order, the parties shall file a joint status report addressing these topics.
