ORDER

RUSSELL G. CLARK, Senior District Judge.

*1 Pending before the Court is the motion of plaintiffs for approval of a budget for 1991–92 for the voluntary interdistrict transfer plan involving the Missouri City School District ("Missouri City"). The proposed budget is an extension without increase in cost of the budget agreed to by the parties for 1990-91 and approved by this Court. The budget for 1991-92 is reasonable and necessary for the continued implementation of the voluntary interdistrict transfer component of the plan for the desegregation of the School District of Kansas City, Missouri ("KCMSD") and is approved.

The State of Missouri defendants are ordered in 1991–92: to fund Missouri City tuition costs of \$5,000 per student for up to ten KCMSD students to attend school in 1991–92 in Missouri City, to pay to Missouri City the difference between Missouri City's cost for a .2 full time equivalent counsellor and the cost of a full time counsellor, to pay to the KCMSD the reasonable cost of a .6 FTE home school coordinator, to pay Missouri City \$8,000 for staff development, and to provide transportation for up to ten KCMSD transfer students under the terms and conditions currently in effect.
