## <u>ORDER</u>

On or about May 12, 2008, Sarah Morrison, an attorney for defendant Honda of America Mfg., Inc. ("HAM") contacted the Court and informed it that the parties had reached a settlement. On or about May 13, 2008, Lawrence Mays, an attorney for plaintiff Equal Employment Opportunity Commission ("EEOC"), also contacted the Court and informed it that this matter had been settled. Some time earlier, Mr. Mays contacted the Court inquiring whether it would be possible to initially file an agreed order on settlement on the public record for a brief period of time, and then later seal the same order.

In light of the settlement, the Court ceased work on HAM's pending motion for summary judgment (Doc. 94). Later, a controversy arose concerning the settlement. HAM then filed a motion to enforce the settlement agreements on May 23, 2008 (Doc.

142). The Court vacated the June 2, 2008 trial date in order to provide sufficient time for the Court to consider and rule on HAM's motion to enforce. Since that time, the Court has scheduled an evidentiary hearing on the motion to enforce to take place on October 27, 2008.

The Court will need to rule upon HAM's motion for summary judgment only if it denies HAM's motion to enforce. For this reason, the Courts **DENIES** HAM's motion for summary judgment (Doc. 94), for statistical purposes only, **WITHOUT PREJUDICE TO RENEWAL OR REFILING** should the Court deny HAM's motion to enforce.

The Clerk shall remove Doc. 94 from the Court's Civil Justice Reform Act motions report.
