IT IS HEREBY AGREED AND STIPULATED that the Avoyelles Bunkie Detention Center in Bunkie, Louisiana, shall operate pursuant to the following housing and staffing requirements, which terms were initially entered into by Consent Decree on March 12, 1990 and modified by an Addendum on October 13, 1994.

The maximum number of inmates which shall be housed in the Avoyelles Bunkie Detention Center in the current housing configuration shall be 258 with the following housing and staffing requirements:

Dormitory 1 - Houses 44 inmates.

Dormitory 2 - Houses 44 inmates.

Dormitory 3 - Houses 44 inmates.

Dormitory 4 - Houses 22 inmates.

Dormitory 5 - Houses 46 inmates.

Dormitory 6 - Houses 58 inmates.
