ORDER

ON THIS DAY, came on for consideration Plaintiff EEOC's Expedited Motion to Quash Subpoena. After considering the motion, the Court is of the opinion that the motion to quash should be granted.

Accordingly, it is hereby ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the subpoena issued to Dr. Byron Kallam, seeking production of any and all medical documents for Ms. Deborah Michelle Bode, be quashed. It is further ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that originals and all copies of any and all of Ms. Bode's medical documents in Defendant's possession be immediately returned to Plaintiff EEOC except for 10 pages of Ms. Bode's medical documents to the extent they contain notations regarding emotional distress experienced by Ms. Bode prior to her termination from her employment with Defendant. All gynecological information on these 10 pages must be excised by the Defendant and the redacted 10 pages must be produced to the EEOC no later than five (5) business days before Ms. Bode's second deposition scheduled for March 29, 2000. Finally, it is ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that, during Ms. Bode's deposition, Defendant shall refrain from asking questions of an embarrassing nature, including but not limited to, questions relating to gynecological issues and marital problems concerning sex.
