ORDER DENYING MOTION TO QUASH SUBPOENA AND

TO COMPER DENYING MOTION

This matter came before the Court for a hearing on December 11, 2003 in connection with a (DOC - 71) Motion to Quash Subpoena filed by the New Mexico Department of Labor. In response to the said motion, the Defendants filed a pleadings labeled "Defendants' Response to Motion to Quash Subpoena or in the Alternative, Motion to Compel Plaintiff To Consent to Production of Unemployment Records." (Doc. 72) The Court finds that Defendants have articulated a compelling need for the unemployment records that were the subject of the Motion to Quash and that, therefore, the said motion as filed by the New Mexico Department of Labor, will be denied. (Doc. 71)

It is therefore ORDERED that the New Mexico Department of Labor will produce all documents pertinent to the unemployment claim of Cheri Brisco, DOB 01/04/58, SSN 459-27-5471 within ten (10) days of the date of this Order. Defendants shall bear all expenses incurred in connection with the production of the documents.

In light of the Court's ruling on the Motion to Quash, it is unnecessary for the Court to address the Defendant's alternative motion to compel the Plaintiff to consent to production of unemployment records and such motion, therefore, is DENIED (DOC. 72).
