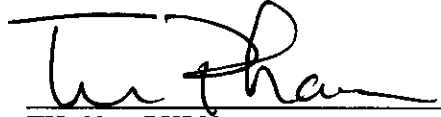
ORDER DENYING PLAINTIFF'S MOTION TO COMPEL

Before the Court is the Equal Employment Opportunity Commission's ("EEOC") Motion to Compel, filed on January 27, 2005 (dkt #12). In its motion, the EEOC seeks an order requiring Defendant Cleveland Construction, Inc. to disclose names of individuals likely to have discoverable information that the Defendant may use to support its claims, as Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 26(a)(1)(A) requires. Defendant responded on February 15, 2005, stating that it disclosed the only four individuals who meet the criteria and that it would supplement its disclosures if it becomes apparent that other individuals have information that Defendant may use. Thus, Plaintiff's Motion to Compel is DENIED AS MOOT. The EEOC may refile this motion at a later date

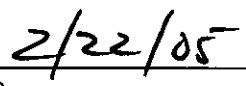
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if appropriate.

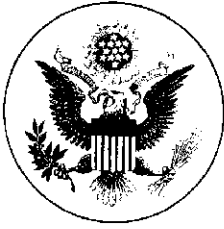
