**ORDER GRANTING PLAINTIFFS' SECOND MOTION TO COMPEL
SITE INSPECTION AND DENYING PLAINTIFFS' MOTION FOR SANCTIONS**

Before the Court is *Plaintiffs' Second Motion to Compel Site Inspection and Motion for Sanctions* (Doc. No. 46) filed on June 7, 2001. Having considered the submission of counsel and the record in this case, the Court is of the opinion that Plaintiffs' motion should be **GRANTED** in part and **DENIED** in part.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that *Plaintiffs' Second Motion to Compel Site Inspection and Motion for Sanctions* (Doc. No. 46) is **GRANTED** with respect to site inspection. The parties shall agree on a convenient time to conduct the site inspection, including Saturday if necessary. The site inspection shall be completed no later than July 15, 2001.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that *Plaintiffs' Second Motion to Compel Site Inspection and Motion for Sanctions* (Doc. No. 46) is **DENIED** with respect to Plaintiffs' request for sanctions.
