
AGREED ORDER ON DEFENDANTS' MOTION TO COMPEL

On January 29 & 30, 2008, the parties conferred regarding Defendants' Motion to Compel regarding Intervenors' Discovery Responses. The conference was held in person and via electronic mail by James Vagnini, representing the Intervenors, Suzanne Anderson, representing Plaintiff EEOC, and Paul Hash and Rachel Ziolkowski, representing Defendants. After concluding the conferences, the parties came to the following agreement. Unless otherwise stated, Intervenors agree to produce the following on a rolling basis beginning on or before February 4, 2008 and concluding on or before February 11, 2008:

- Intervenor Mark Barrett, Henry Firth, Tristian Fernandez and David McCoy shall produce substantive responses to Defendants' first set of interrogatories and requests for production. These Intervenor's interrogatory responses will be properly verified.
- Chris DiGiorgio, Walter Kelley, Wilborn Lyles, Mark Nelson, Diana Ochoa (as representative for Francisco Ochoa), Jerome Sloan, Josh Toran, Mark Webster, and Willie Winters will provide verifications to their interrogatory responses.
- All Intervenor's will continue to produce subsequent employment, tax and wage information as well as all medical records responsive to Defendants' requests for production.
- Intervenor's will supplement their discovery responses in accordance with the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure.

This Court, therefore, GRANTS Defendants' Motion to Compel and ORDERS the Intervenor's to comply with this agreement.
